EL CAPRICHO DE GAUDÍ:

Daily, open from 10:30 to 21:00h. (last admission at 20:30h). **Guided visits:** 11:00, 11:30, 12:00, 12:30, 13:00, 13:30, 16:00, 16:30, 17:00, 17:30, 18:00, 18:30, 19:00 and 19:30h.

Saturday 09th July open until 19:00h. (last admission at 18:30h).

Ticket price: General admission: 7€. Reduced (accreditation required: retired, persons with accredited disabilities, students, large family, unemployed): 5€. From 7 to 14 years old: 3€. Children under 7 years old: free.

THE SOBRELLANO PALACE AND THE CHAPEL-MAUSOLEUM OF THE MARQUIS OF COMILLAS:

Monday to Sunday: from 9:50 to 19:30 pm (last visit 18:40pm.)

INFORMATIVE NOTE: On Monday, July 4th. from 10:00 am to 14:00 pm, the center will remain closed for recording.

- Ticket price SOBRELLANO PALACE: Normal: 5€. Reduced: 3€ (large families, major of 65 years or pensioners, student card and persons with 65% of functional disability. Previous accreditation). **Children/School groups:** 1,5 € (from 4 to 12 years, both inclusive). Free: from 0 to 3 years.

- Ticket price CHAPEL-PANTHEON: Normal: 5€. Reduced: 3€ (large families, major of 65 years or pensioners, student card and persons with 65% of functional disability. Previous accreditation). **Children/School groups:** 1,5 € (from 4 to 12 years, both inclusive). Free: from 0 to 3 years.

COMILLAS MAJOR SEMINARY:

Monday to Sunday: from 9:50 to 14:00pm (last visit 13:40pm) and from 15:00 to 19:30pm (last visit 18:40pm).

You can combine your visit to the Major Seminary with the Palace and the Chapel-Pantheon of Sobrellano in Comillas. If you buy your ticket in advance online, you must leave a time interval of, at least, 90 minutes between the Major Seminary and Sobrellano.

SPECIAL VISIT: During the year, on Saturdays, in the session at 10:10, a more extensive guided tour is carried out, accessing non-visitable spaces apart from the usual route. On the visit, it is possible that spaces not suitable for people with reduced mobility will be visited.

Maximum capacity per session: 20 people. Approximately 1 hour 30 minutes. *Previous accreditation
