### EL CAPRICHO DE GAUDÍ:

**Daily**, from 10:30 to 17:30hrs (last admission 17:00h). **Spanish guided tours:** 11:00, 12:00, 13:00 and 16:00 hrs. **From 2<sup>nd</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> December:** Open from 10:30 to 19:00hrs (last admission 18:30hrs) **Spanish guided tours:** From 11:00 to 13:30 and from 16:00 to 17:30 (every 30 minutes). **Closed on 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> December**

**Ticket price:** General admission: 7€. Reduced (accreditation required: people over 65, persons with accredited disabilities, students, teachers, large family, unemployed): 5€. From 7 to 12 years old: 3€. Children under 7 years old: free.

**Ticket price SOBRELLANO PALACE:** Normal: 5€. Reduced: 3€ (large families, major of 65 years or pensioners, student card and persons with 65% of functional disability. Previous accreditation). **Children/School groups:** 1,5 € (from 4 to 12 years, both inclusive). Free: from 0 to 3 years.

**Ticket price CHAPEL-PANTHEON:** Normal: 5€. Reduced: 3€ (large families, major of 65 years or pensioners, student card and persons with 65% of functional disability. (Previous accreditation). **Children/School groups:** 1,5 € (from 4 to 12 years, both inclusive). Free: from 0 to 3 years.

**The last access to the gardens will be 30 minutes before closing. The visit of the interior of the monuments is exclusively guided, according to availability (only in Spanish language).**

**Guided visit rates: Normal:** 5 € (major of 13 years). **Reduced:** 3 € (large families, major of 65 years or pensioners, student card and persons with 65% of functional disability) \*. **Children/School groups:** 1,5 € (from 4 to 12 years, both inclusive). **Free:** from 0 to 3 years (both inclusive). **Free access:** ICOMOS members, Official Guides of Cantabria and holders of the CULTURAL PASSPORT\*. Maximum capacity per session: 40 people. Approximately 45 minutes. **The visit of the interior of the building is exclusively guided, according to availability (only in Spanish language).** \* Previous accreditation.
