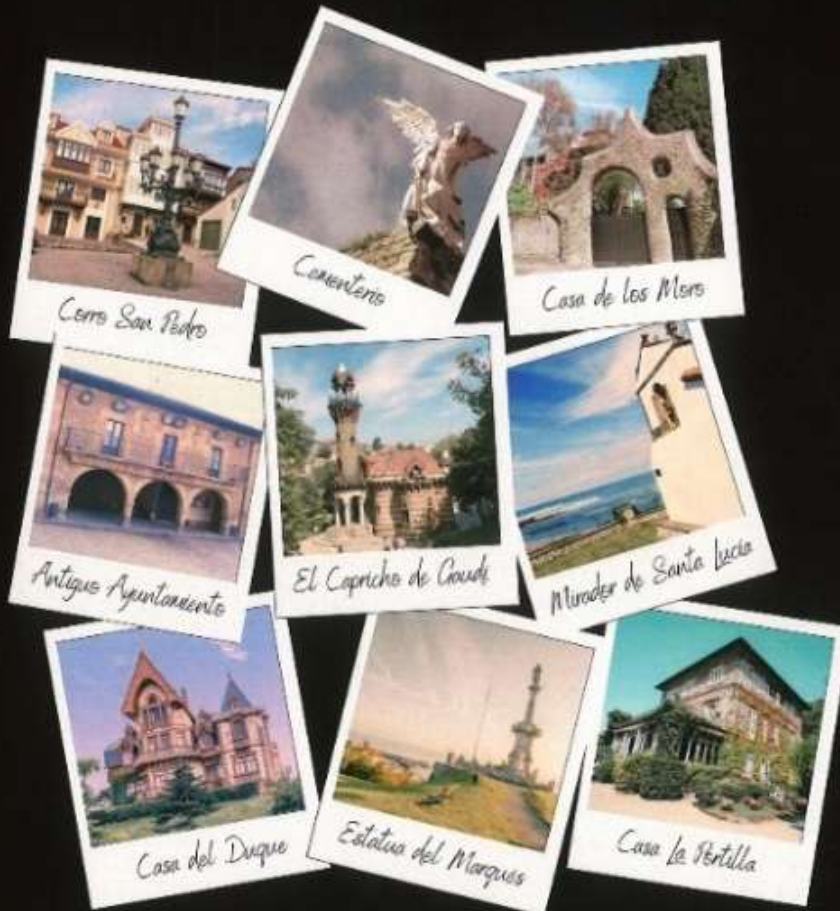

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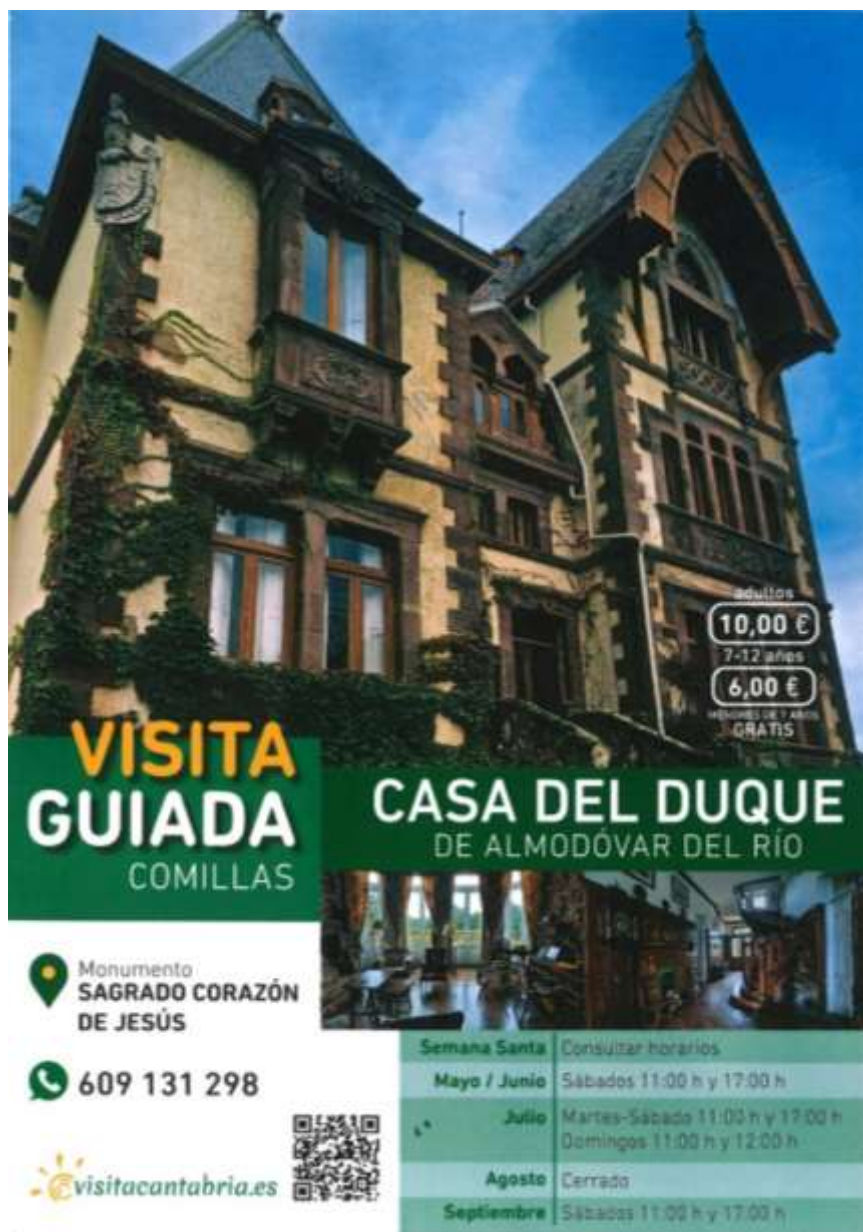

“CAMINO DE SANTIAGO” AND “CAMINO LEBANIEGO”

On the route of the “Camino de la Costa”, shell pilgrims cross the town of **Comillas**. The “**Caminos de Santiago del Norte**” were added to the **UNESCO World Heritage** List in 2015. This decision completes the recognition granted to the “Camino Francés” in 1993. The four new routes that have been incorporated are: the “Camino Primitivo”, the “Camino de la Costa”, the “Camino Interior Vasco-Riojano” and the “Camino Lebaniego”. In **Cantabria**, the “Camino del Norte de la Costa” and the “Camino Lebaniego” pass through, with the latter being the pilgrimage route to Santo Toribio de Liébana, which spans 72 kilometers between San Vicente de la Barquera and the Monastery of Santo Toribio de Liébana.

CASTILLO DEL REY IN SAN VICENTE DE LA BARQUERA

A coastal fortification with origins dating back to the 8th century. It hosts exhibitions and offers stunning views of the town over the estuaries of San Vicente de la Barquera.

Location: Calle Alta, s/n (pedestrian street in the old town).

Visiting hours: Tuesday to Sunday, from 11:00 to 14:00 and from 17:30 to 20:00. **Closed on Mondays.**

Prices: Adults: 2€; children from 4 to 16 years old: 1€.

Next to the castle is part of **the wall** that surrounded the old citadel, with remnants still preserved, as well as the gates through which pilgrims traveling the coastal route of the **Camino de Santiago** passed. From San Vicente de la Barquera, the **Camino Lebaniego** begins, a 72-kilometer pilgrimage to the Monastery of Santo Toribio de Liébana. At the **Punta de la Silla Lighthouse**, you'll find the **Interpretation Center of the Oyambre Natural Park and the Saja Nansa Protected Natural Area**. The town is particularly notable for its location between the

Rubín and Pombo estuaries, over which cross the **Puente de la Maza** and the **Puente Nuevo**, respectively, within the Oyambre Natural Park.

In the **old town**, you can also admire the **Palacio de Los Corro** (current Town Hall), the **Torre del Preboste** (temporary exhibitions), the ruins of the **Hospital de la Concepcion**, and visit **the Church of Santa María de Los Ángeles**. The **Convent of San Luis** is only open for visits on specific occasions and with prior reservation at the **San Vicente de la Barquera Tourist Office**.

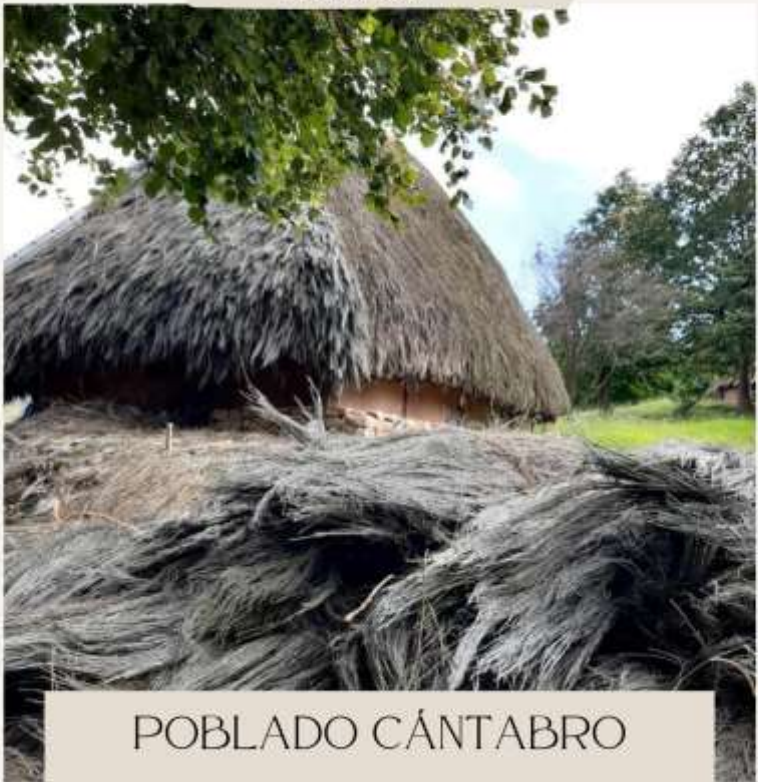

Recently renovated, the museum offers a journey from the origins of the universe. Located in an impressive building from 1720, featuring a manor house and chapel, declared a Cultural Heritage Site (BIC) in 1984.

Located in the municipality of **Herrerías**, on the banks of the Nansa River, this forge transports us to a traditional way of life, as if time had stood still, and its walls once again echo the incessant noise of the bellows and the hammer striking iron.

FERRERÍA (Ironworks) AND MILL OF CADES

The building is part of a rural complex from the 18th century, completed in 1752.

Its design is typical of Cantabrian forges: a sturdy masonry structure with two main halls connected to each other, housing the hydraulic machinery, and four coal bunkers attached transversely. Its impressive size, along with excellent hydraulic engineering, makes it one of the finest examples of this type.

The mill adjacent to the forge completes this interesting rural ensemble. As a cycle concludes, the water returns to the Nansa River, from which it is diverted to operate the machinery. During guided tours, the machines are activated, immersing visitors in the life of the blacksmiths and millers of that era.
